

DAD PLATE



MATERIALS

- Bisque: Smooth Dinner Plate
- Pen Template Masking Tape
 Tracing Paper
 Medium Round Brush
 Small Round Brush
 Detail Brush
 Liner Brush
 - Paint: 31, 19, 90, 47, 64

TIPS

- To trace the design onto plate, tape the template in place and slide the tracing paper under it. Use a pen.
- When using a Liner brush, water down the paint. It will flow better.
- To make dots, use the back tip of a brush handle. Dip it into underglaze and touch the plate to make each dot.

Color Me Mine

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Trace the design onto the center of the plate. Complete outlines by adding an extended border to the background shape and a few circles as shown in the sample image.

2. Outline the letters and the background shapes using Black # 31 and a Liner brush. Apply two coats.

3. Color in the letters using Red # 90 and a medium round brush. Apply three coats.

4. Paint the background shape behind the letters with Yellow # 19. Apply three coats.

5. Paint the extended shape with Blue # 47. Apply three coats.

6. Add a third coat to all black outlines.

7. Use the back of a detail brush to make dots in the white areas of the plate with Blue # 64.
